## GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS

### RESPONSIBILITY

Rocky Mountain Tours, a division of Ski.com, (Agent) gives notice that all tickets, vouchers and coupons issued by Agent and all arrangements for transportation and conveyance or for sightseeing services or any other service made by Agent are made by Agent as dual Agent for the Passenger and for the suppliers, hotels or other suppliers, upon the express condition that Agent is not liable for injury, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity which may be occasioned either by reasons of defect in any vehicle or through the act or default of any company or person that is engaged in conveying the passenger, furnishing rental cars, furnishing sightseeing services, or that participates in carrying out the arrangements of the tour or otherwise in connection therewith, or any hotel or lodging or employee of said hotel and lodging. The issuance and acceptance of tickets and vouchers shall be deemed to be consent to these conditions.

### DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENT

A deposit of \$400 per person is due within 7 days of making reservations. A written confirmation will be forwarded upon receipt of deposit. Full payment must be received by Rocky Mountain Tours 60 days prior to travel (December 30, 2011).

### CHANGES IN LATE BOOKING

Any change in the reservation after your deposit has been received will be charged a \$50 per person change fee prior to 60 days. Within 60 days the change fee is \$75 per person. If booked within 30 days of travel, full payment is due immediately. If reservations are made after January 3, 2012 a \$50 late booking fee will be charged. Within 14 days, a rush charge such as express delivery, will be required with final payment.

### CANCELLATION POLICY
